
Application Components

- i. 3,000-character limit for Academic/Research and ETA
- ii. 6,000- character limit for Creative & Performing Arts

2. 3 Short Essay Prompts

- ii. Flexibility & Adaptability (2,000 character limit)
- iii. Community Engagement (2,000-character limit)
- iv. Impact of Fulbright Award (1,000-character limit)





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Application Components

3. Evaluator & References

- Foreign Language Evaluation
 - o "Required" "Recommended"
- Three (3) References
 - Research/Study 3 letters
 - ETA 3 people answering 5 questions

4. Transcripts




